

# LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

## **1 Corinthians 11-14: Worship That Builds**

**Sermon:** 1 Corinthians 12

**Date:** Sunday, April 19, 2026

1. *Read 1 Corinthians 12:1-3.* Why does Paul emphasize that he doesn't want the Corinthians to be "uninformed" about spiritual gifts? What were they getting wrong?
2. *Read verses 4-7.* In what ways does the diversity within the Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) serve as a model for how unity and diversity should coexist within the church body?
3. *Review verses 8-10 and verse 28.* What stands out to you about the variety of gifts listed? Why do you think Paul prioritizes apostles, prophets, and teachers?

4. Have you ever identified your spiritual gift(s)? If yes, how did you discover those gifts? (Spiritual Gifts Survey, a friend/family member encouraged you, discovered through serving, etc.) If no, consider taking a Spiritual Gifts Survey or asking your life group for insight.
5. How does understanding that spiritual gifts are given by the Holy Spirit for the common good of the church challenge the way we typically think about our individual talents and abilities?
6. Paul addresses both inferiority (verses 14-20) and superiority (verses 21-26) in the body. Which tendency do you struggle with more - feeling like you don't have much to offer, or viewing your contribution as more important than others?
7. *Read verses 26-27* Read verses 26-27. What does it practically look like for our group to "suffer together" and "rejoice together"?
