1. Because God ______. "A tenth of all you produce is the Lord's, and it is holy." Leviticus 27:30 (NIRV)

2. Because Jesus ______. "Yes, you should tithe, and you shouldn't leave the more important things undone either." Matthew 23:23 (LB)

3. Tithing demonstrates that God is _____. "The purpose of tithing is to teach you to always put God in first place in your life." Deuteronomy 14:23 (LB)

4. Tithing reminds me that ______ was given to me by God! "Always remember that it is the Lord your God who gives you the ability to produce wealth." Deuteronomy 8:18 (LB)

"Each of you should bring a gift in proportion to the way the Lord your God has blessed you." Deuteronomy 16:17 (NIV)
