THE TABERNACLE (GOD DWELLING WITH HUMANITY)

REVELATION 21:3-7

INTRODUCTION TO THE TABERNACLE

Tabernacle generally refers to a sacred portable sanctuary used by the Israelites during their wilderness wanderings.

It serves as the physical location where God's divine presence dwelt among his people.

Exodus 25:8-9

- Let them make a sanctuary that I may dwell with them.
- Let them make peace
- Let them prepare their heart
- Let them come before me

THE THREE CHAMBERS OF THE TABERNACLE

- The Outer Courtyard (where sacrifices are made)
- The Holy Place (where priests tender the Golden Stand and Altar of Incense)
- The Holy of Holies (the most sacred room), it housed the ark of the covenant that is a gold-covered wooden chest that held the stone tablets of the ten commandment)

CHRIST IN THE THREE CHAMBERS

Many bible scholars see the three chambers as illustrating a believer's spiritual journey:

Chamber	Experience	Spiritual Application
Outer Court	Salvation	Repentance and forgiveness
Holy Place	Growth	Worship, prayer and God's word
Holy of Holies	Intimacy	Deep communion with God

The tabernacle reveals God's desire to bring people from sacrifice, through fellowship, into His Presence.

GOD'S PROMISE OF RESTORATION

God shall wipe away all tears and there shall be no more death (Revelation 21:4). We know that life brings blessings and comfort. Pain and sorrow are inevitable, but God is bringing us to a place of restoration (psalm 30:5b)

“Behold I make all things new” (Revelation 2:5).

This is a declaration by God, indicating a future, total restoration where all suffering, decay and sins will be eliminated to establish a prefect, eternal heaven and earth.

- He renews the heart
- He renews minds
- He renews lives

Verses: 2 Corinthians 5:17-18 & Romans 12:2

THE SOVEREIGNTY AND ETERNAL NATURE OF GOD

It is done; I am Alpha and Omega. The Beginning and the End.
(Revelation 21:6)

These signifies God sovereignty over everything.

God is not limited by time, He is present at the beginning, throughout the process and already at the outcome. Jeremiah 1:5 – “Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you”

JESUS: THE FOUNTAIN OF LIVING WATER

- I will give unto him, that is athirst of the fountain of water of life freely (Revelation 21:6)
- God will completely satisfy the spiritual emptiness of anyone who humbly seeks him. Offering them eternal life and grace at no cost.

John 7:37-38 – “Jesus offers river of living water to those who believe in Him.

VICTORY OVER THE WORLD THROUGH FAITH
