WARM-UP

 What do the prayers you have been praying for the last week say about your heart? What does it mean to pray from a thankful heart?

Thought #1 – Moving Forward: Prayer is the tracks in front of the train.

Verses: Colossians 4:2-6, 1:3

- Think of people who make you "light up" when you get to talk to them vs. people who make you cringe or "power down". What's the difference? How does it feel knowing that Jesus longs to hear from us in prayer?
- Pastor Kevin said, "Many short prayers can be just as powerful as one long prayer."
 What short sentence or word prayers do you pray most often? How is this helpful for you?
- Many believers say that they pray throughout the day. Some might not

understand this. How would you explain it, practically speaking? What's the benefit of this sort of all-day-long abiding?

Thought # 2 - Be Alert in Prayer!

Verses: Colossians 4:2-6

- As a group, list things that tend to distract "us" from prayer.
- How can we combat these distractions?
- What practical things can we do to stay alert in prayer?

Thought #3 Live Wisely, Making the Most of the Opportunity Given!

Verses: Colossians 4:2-6

- How can we be ready to take full advantage of the opportunities that God gives?
- Tell your story. Tell of a time in your life when God gave you an opportunity to invest or care for another. What made you realize that this was a God-given opportunity? How did you take full advantage of the opportunity? What was the outcome? How do you feel knowing that this opportunity was a gift from God to you and this other person?
