

The Story: Moses

MAIN SCRIPTURE: Exodus 1:6-8, Exodus 3:1-15

Opening Discussion

- What thoughts, feelings, or impressions do you have about the sermon this week?

Thought #1 – God greatly desires to have our attention!

- Read Exodus 3:2-4. How did God get Moses’s attention in this passage? Pastor Kevin reminded us that just as God made Himself known to Moses in a creative way to capture his attention, He does that with us today. Why do you think it’s important that we fix our attention in the right place when it comes to how God is moving in our lives? What obstacles do you face in your life that sometimes make this difficult? Share a time, past or present, when God got your attention in a creative way.

Thought #2 – God shows up on behalf of His people!

- Review Exodus 3:7 together. How does this reveal the heart of God? Pastor Kevin shared several ways that we can hear from God. Whether it’s through reminding us of how He showed up in the past, bringing to mind a specific scripture, or sending someone to encourage us at the exact moment we need it. What are some ways you have heard from God in your time of pain or misery? How has God shown up for you, whether in the past or present? Sharing these stories can cause faith to rise in others, so let this be a time of bragging about what God has done for you.

Thought #3 – God is BIG ENOUGH to do something about it!

- Read Exodus 3:6, 14-15. Pastor Kevin reminded us that in this passage, God was inviting Moses into something bigger than himself or his own power. How have you

seen God, past or present, inviting you into something bigger than yourself? He is the same God that demonstrated His power by freeing the Israelites. How has He made His power known in your life? What are you trusting God to be big enough to handle in your life right now? Has there been a time when God has shown up for someone else THROUGH you?

Thought #4 – God is faithful to rescue His people!

- In Exodus 3:8-10 God shows who is actually in charge. He is! Share a time God has brought you out of captivity in your life. How has he been faithful to rescue you from your circumstances or from oppression? What BIG, unmovable thing has He proven to be bigger than (like the Red Sea) in your life? Have you ever wondered like the Israelites “Is the Lord among us”? Have you found yourself in a hard place, past or present, where it is hard to remember God's promises? How can you remember God’s promise, His faithfulness, and rescue even in the face of difficult moments?
