**MAIN SCRIPTURE: Matthew 6:9-13**

- <sup>9</sup> Pray like this: Our Father in heaven,  
    may your name be kept holy.
- <sup>10</sup> May your Kingdom come soon.  
May your will be done on earth,  
    as it is in heaven.
- <sup>11</sup> Give us today the food we need,
- <sup>12</sup> and forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven  
those who sin against us.
- <sup>13</sup> And don't let us yield to temptation,  
    but rescue us from the evil one.

**Thought #1 – We elevate God to the highest place of honor!**

Verses: Matthew 6:9-13

- When you enter most conversations, do you think your typical inclination is to be known by others or to know others? Why do you say this?
- When you enter into prayer, do you think your typical inclination is to be known by God or to know God?
- What might be the benefit of acknowledging God and His kingdom first (before acknowledging ourselves or our own needs) as we enter into prayer?

**Thought #2 – When we usher in a Kingdom, we usher in a King!**

Verses: Matthew 6:9-13

- Are you comforted by or discouraged by the thought that you are not ultimately in charge of your own life? Why?
- How would you say your will and your "kingdom" presently differ from God's will and God's kingdom? In what ways do you think they align? Why do you say this?

**Thought #3 – His Kingdom is partially seen now and fully realized later!**

Verses: Matthew 6:9-13

- Pastor Kevin said, "We still live in a world of good news and bad news. There are times we see beautiful things happening that point to God being at work, and then other times when we are fully aware that God has much work yet to be done." How have you experienced the tension between seeing God's work unfold in the present vs. hoping for his work to be revealed in the future?
- What do you see/experience God doing in the world around you today or during this season?
- What are you hoping to see in the future?
