1. When you were a child, what were the most fun things you did with mud? Any stories from your later years as an adult?

- 2. Why might the disciples have thought that sin caused the man's blindness? What problem does Jesus (vs. 3) note about their faulty reasoning?
- 3. How does this statement compare with Jesus' words in John 5:14? What is the relationship between sin and suffering?
- 4. What part does faith play in this healing? How is it demonstrated?
- 5. How does this healing support Jesus claims to be the Christ? Why does this matter?

### REFLECT

- 6. Have you ever been tempted to view illness or a handicap like the disciples and Pharisee? Why?
- 7. What was the last miracle Jesus did your life? What "mud" did He use? Who else was a part of that moment?
- 8. When is it most difficult for you to have faith in the power of God? How might you demonstrate your faith in this area today?
