#### Dig

Which of these disciples do you most identify with? Why?
- What questions might you still have about the importance of the resurrection?

### Dig

- Have you ever experienced a miracle in your life?
- o Do you ever pray for miracles for yourself or others? Why or why not?

## These might help...

- Isaiah 43:1 (fear) But now this is what the Lord says... do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are mine."
- Psalm 145:3 (understanding)
  Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; His greatness no one can fathom
- Mark 9:24 (doubt) Immediately the father of the Child cried out and said with tears, 'I believe! Help me in my unbelief'
- Psalm 42:11 (hope) Why and I so sad? Why am I so troubled? I will put my hope in God, and once again I will praise Him, my savior
