Pastor Aaron's message this week should read like a headline..."Easter 2021....GOOD NEWS!" Not good news about a virus, politics, legislation...Good News in the Name of JESUS! We need the reminder of the Good News of Jesus after this last year! The Good News is so much deeper than we can comprehend. It is that Christ **Died** for our sins, He was **Buried** and He was **Resurrected** from the dead! It is in that resurrection that we are made alive in Christ if we choose to accept it.

### **Community Prayer:**

### **Opening Questions**

1. Think about Easter through the lens of your maturing over the years...What did Easter mean to you as a child? As an Adult? As a member of the Body of Christ?

#### **EXPLORATION**

Read the passages below...what can you learn about what it means to follow Jesus from these passages? (Have someone read from their bible)

#### 1 Corinthians 15: 1-2

- 2. Why is it important for you to be reminded of the message of the Gospel (Good News)?
- 3. What stand have you taken since becoming a Follower of Jesus?
- 4. How do you hold firmly to what you have been taught by the Gospel? What does that look like in your daily life?
- 5. Have you ever wrestled with your faith to the point where your beliefs were challenged? Talk about that time and the circumstances and how you found your way back to the Truth of the Gospel.

#### 1 Corinthians 15: 3-4

- 6. What is the threefold message of the Gospel?
- 7. Where do we find the proof of this Good News?

- 8. How does God's demonstration of His love toward us make you feel?
- 9. What does this say about your ability to obtain salvation based on your works?

#### **Christ was Buried: Testifies that He really died**

#### Isaiah 53: 8-9

This prophecy took place 600 years before Jesus was born.

- 10. Why do you think none of the Disciples or other followers protested Jesus oppression and judgment?
- 11. Who was this Rich man mentioned in this passage who allowed Jesus body to be laid in his tomb? (Matthew 27: 57-60)

- 17. Why is our labor in the Lord not in vain? What does your labor look like in today's world?
