August 8

Pastor Aaron continued the current series entitled: "From the Ground Up" out of the Book of Nehemiah. This week his topic was on the Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity, and Ambiguity that we can sometimes experience, especially in times like these. VOLATILITY is a result of things changing so fast and UNCERTAINTY is a result of our inability to predict what is next. As we encounter multiple and competing forces with no clear cause & effect, we are confronted with the COMPLEXITY of things. There is a haziness of reality that can cause us to misread things due to the AMBIGUITY. For many of us this season has been filled with V.U.C.A. and this week's message helps us to put that into perspective.

All of us are having to deal with this on a daily basis as we are challenged by this Delta Variant and other situations in our lives. Opening Questions

 Have you heard about V.U.C.A. before? What are your thoughts? If not, what are your initial thoughts after hearing about V.U.C.A. (VOLATILITY, UNCERTAINTY, COMPLEXITY, AND AMBIGUITY?)

Read the passages below...what can you learn about what it means to follow Jesus from these passages? (Have someone read from their bible)

- 3. What is an example of conflict that Nehemiah faced that stands out to you?
 - a. What is a similar example in your life or in our world?

Nehemiah 4:4-6

4. Nehemiah's first response after this attack was to pray, what is your first response following an attack?

- a. Give an example of when you went to prayer as a first response or a time when you WISHED you would have.
- 5. What do you appreciate about the way that Nehemiah faced the opposition in his life?

6. Why is it important for you to take some action steps following your prayers to God?

- 7. In what ways do you feel like you sometimes contribute to the conflict/opposition, or V.U.C.A. in any given week? (ie: gossip, complaining, slander, not giving the benefit of the doubt, etc.)
 - a. What are better ways to respond to these challenges of life?

Nehemiah 5:1-12

8. Have you ever been taken advantage of by a family member or a close friend? How did you handle the situation? Prayer? Retreat? Confront? Talk about which direction (or combination) you took and the result. Do you wish you had done it differently?

Opposition that is Personal

Nehemiah 6:3-4

- 9. How have you experienced different kinds of opposition or conflict?
 - a. From the outside? From the inside? The Personal kind?

Nehemiah 6:15-16

- 10. How can turning to Jesus bring the hope we desperately need in times of V.U.C.A.?
 - a. How does He accomplish the move to faithful, understanding, dependence?

The Antidote to V.U.C.A. (Note the "DOUBLE V.U.C.A.")

- Volatility is cured by Vision
- Uncertainty is cured by **Understanding**
- Complexity is cured by Courage
- Ambiguity is cured by **Adaptability**
