TAKE IT WITH YOU

Our lives are filled with noise. We live on busy streets. We go to school and work and hear everybody bustling about. But we are surrounded by a much more sinister noise. As we try to make our way through the world, we are constantly bombarded by noise from the outside. I mean, of course, the distractions in our lives. At college, this is all too familiar a scenario: A busy day ahead of me, homework, tests, social events. The workload seems overwhelming. And when I think I have enough on my plate already, worrying about what I have to do, the noise comes in so loud: How am I going to manage my time? Did I mess up? Did I mismanage something? I hope I didn't make a mistake on that test. Ah, I should have studied more. What would my family think? What will my friends think? I have to figure out how I'll schedule today. And am I dressed right? What are others thinking? What are others wearing? What should I think of them? And I still have to figure out bible study.

Stop. Be quiet. *Be Still*. When was the last time we were quiet with God? God told Job "Stop, and consider the wonders of God" (Job 37:14). Noise is the work of the enemy. He wants us to hear the noise, because it distracts us from God. I have always loved what CS Lewis said about heaven: there will be either singing or silence, idle noise is for this realm. There is something profoundly comforting, something orienting, in sitting in silence and thinking of Him. When the noise of life is coming at us from every direction, let us try to be still, and block out the noise of this life for the quietness of divine contemplation.
