Today, we conclude our series on the first three chapters of Revelation, and ask God, "Please check and correct my alignment with You." We desire to be fully aligned with Jesus' Spirit, and experience life to its fullest as overcomers.

In this letter, we see Jesus confront a church that is self-deceived and slacking. His challenge is to be **All In**; His invitation is to a real lasting relationship.
