ΤΑΚΕ ΙΤ WITH YOU

In all four gospel accounts of Peter's denial of Jesus, there are two common elements: people recognized Peter as a follower of Jesus, and Peter denied that identity. Let's put ourselves in that story, in a moment where we are asked, "aren't you with Jesus? Aren't you one of his followers?"

How are we recognized as followers of Jesus?

- **By how we speak**: Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone. Colossians 4:6
- **By how we serve**: Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?' "Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me. Matthew 25:37-40
- By how we love: By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another. John 13:35

How do we deny Christ?

- **By how we speak**: Don't you see that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and then out of the body? But the things that come out of a person's mouth come from the heart, and these defile them. For out of the heart come evil thoughts—murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander. These are what defile a person; but eating with unwashed hands does not defile them. Matthew 15:17-20
- When we fail to serve: They also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?' "He will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.' Matthew 25:44-45
- By our lack of love: If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. 1Corinthians 13:1-3

May everything that we do and say bear witness to our love, of God and of our neighbor. May our words, our actions, and our love be evidence that we are followers of Christ.
