Transformation of the Heart

The heart is far more complex than merely grit, courage, feelings, and emotions. Rather, it is the foundation of our being, the core of our identity, and seat from which we determine our values, desires, morals, and our connections with others. The heart is also the intersection of where God meets with us. It is where He reveals Himself to us and for us as believers, where He is present in us.

Matthew 6:21 "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Matthew 12:34 "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks."

Matthew 15:8 "This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me."

I. The Soil of the Hardened Heart

Mark 4:15 And these are the ones along the path, where the word is sown: when they hear, Satan immediately comes and takes away the word that is sown in them.II. The Soil of the Half Heart

Mark 4:16-17 And these are the ones sown on rocky ground: the ones who, when they hear the word, immediately receive it with joy. ¹⁷ And they have no root in themselves, but endure for a while; then, when tribulation or persecution arises on account of the word, immediately they fall away.

Psalm 1:3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers.

III. The Soil of the Distracted Heart

Mark 4:18-19 And others are the ones sown among thorns. They are those who hear the word, ¹⁹ but the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches and the desires for other things enter in and choke the word, and it proves unfruitful.

Jeremiah 2:13 For my people have committed two evils: they have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters, and hewed out cisterns for themselves, broken cisterns that can hold no water.

IV: The Soil of the Good Heart

Mark 4:20 But those that were sown on the good soil are the ones who hear the word and accept it and bear fruit, thirtyfold and sixtyfold and a hundredfold.

God created our heart to crave Him, and we starve it by feeding it the things of this world.
