TAKE IT WITH YOU

Many years ago I learned the acronym, "PRAY", reminding me to start prayer with Praise. Jesus taught His disciples to pray in this same way in The Lord's Prayer.

P-PRAISE

R- REPENT

A- ASK

Y- YIELD

Sometimes our hearts are so heavy with burdens for others or perhaps in our own lives, that we truly don't know what to pray. Romans 8:26-27 promises that the Spirit Himself intercedes for us as God's people when we can't find the words.

²⁶ In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. ²⁷ And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.

In Allen Pote's music to Psalm 139, our Youth Choir reminds us beautifully today that God is always with us and therefore hears every prayer.

"Lord you have searched me and known me. You know everything I do. When I rise up, when I lie down, You are with me through and through. Before a word is on my tongue, you know what I will say, your presence follows me day by day. Search me, O God, and know me, Try me and know my heart. See if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. Amen."

The National Day of Prayer theme on May 2 is "Lift Up The Word - Light Up The World", with 2 Samuel 22:29-31 as the theme verse:

For you are my lamp, O Lord, and my God lightens my darkness. For by You I can run against a troop, and by my God I can leap over a wall. This God—his way is perfect; the word of the Lord proves true; He is a shield for all those who take refuge in Him.

May we "Lift Up The Word and Light Up The World" with our prayers.
