Questions to ask and Things to remember:

- ✓ When am I creating space in my schedule to draw near to Jesus and pay attention to Him? Joy comes in proximity to Jesus and in paying attention to His word and His Spirit.
- ✓ Where are my eyes fixed? If Jesus endured the cross in light of joy, I can endure this.
- ✓ What should I be counting as joy? God will not allow me to be burdened beyond his ability to uphold me. I can stay faithful and count it as joy.
- ✓ Am I holding onto "yesterday" when I should be holding onto Jesus?
- ✓ Am I allowing what I do not have to rob me of what I do have in this moment while I think of "Some day"? God has me in this moment to fulfill his purposes in me and through me.
