I remember when my Daddy told me I would get "3 dimes" each Saturday with instructions that I would give one of those dimes to the church to tithe. I was tiny and it wasn't until later that I realized one dime out of three was more than 10 percent. I also remember our Pastor's wife, an "in town" grandmother to me, buying lemonade at my lemonade stand and finding me the next morning in Sunday School to confirm how much money I made. During this season of commitment for our future generations, I'm thankful for those who have gone before us both in our family and in our church family.
