INVITATION TO HOLY MONDAY

Dear people of God, after our Lord Jesus entered Jerusalem, his first public act was to visit the Temple, the house of his Father in heaven, which he had frequented since he was a boy. On this occasion Christ showed his zeal for worship, driving out the moneychangers whose commerce inhibited prayer. As we commemorate Christ's cleansing of the Temple on this Holy Monday, let us remember that in Christ we are Temples of the Holy Spirit. By God's grace, today we repent of our sins and receive assurance of God's forgiveness, that we might worship him in Spirit and in Truth.

Priest Let us pray:



THE LITANY OF PENITENCE

For all our unfaithfulness and disobedience; for the pride, vanity, and hypocrisy of our lives; Lord:

Have mercy upon us.



For our self-pity and impatience, and our envy of those we think more fortunate than ourselves; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For our unrighteous anger, bitterness, and resentment; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For our sexual impurity, our exploitation of other people, and our failure to give of ourselves in love; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For our self-indulgent appetites and ways, and our intemperate pursuit of worldly goods and comforts; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For our dishonesty in daily life and work, our ingratitude for thy gifts, and our failure to heed thy call; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For our blindness to human need and suffering, and our indifference to injustice and cruelty; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For our wastefulness and misuse of thy creation, and our lack of concern for those who come after us; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For all false judgements, for prejudice and contempt of others, and for all uncharitable thoughts and actions toward our neighbors; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For our negligence in prayer and worship, for our presumption and abuse of thy means of grace; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

For seeking the praise of others rather than the approval of God; Lord: **Have mercy upon us.**

THE CONFESSION

Priest Let us confess our sins against God and our neighbor.

Almighty and most merciful Father, we have erred and strayed from thy ways like lost sheep. We have followed too much the devices and desires of our own hearts. We have offended against thy holy laws. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done, and we have done those things which we ought not to have done, and there is no health in us. But thou, O Lord, have mercy upon us, miserable offenders. Spare thou those, O God, which confess their fault, restore thou those that are penitent, according to thy promises declared unto mankind in Christ Jesus our Lord. And grant, O most merciful father, for his sake, that we may hereafter live a godly, righteous, and sober life, to the glory of thy holy name. Amen.

THE ABSOLUTION

Almighty God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, desires not the death of sinners, but that they may turn from their wickedness and live. He has empowered and commanded his ministers to pronounce to his people, being penitent, the absolution and remission of their sins. He now pardons and absolves all who truly repent and with sincere hearts believe his holy Gospel. For this reason, we beseech him to grant us true repentance and his Holy Spirit, that our present deeds may please him, the rest of our lives may be pure and holy, and that at the last we may come to his eternal joy; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

Jeremiah 7:3-11

THE GOSPEL

Luke 19:45-20:8

Lector The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, according to Luke.

People **Glory be to thee, Lord Christ.**

And he entered the temple and began to drive out those who sold, saying to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be a house of prayer,' but you have made it a den of robbers."

And he was teaching daily in the temple. The chief priests and the scribes and the principal men of the people were seeking to destroy him, but they did not find anything they could do, for all the people were hanging on his words.

One day, as Jesus was teaching the people in the temple and preaching the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes with the elders came up and said to him, "Tell us by what authority you do these things, or who it is that gave you this authority."
