Picking Sides – Knowing Your Why – John 7:40-52

- I. Allow your “why” to be determined by this “who” (v. 45-49)
- II. When Jesus is your “why,” you can have courage in the face of persecution (v. 48-51)
- III. Do not expect the other side to understand your “why” (v. 52)
