Healing the Man Born Blind - God's Might on Display

Gospel of John Series – John 9:1-11

Wednesday, April 22, 2020

- I. Some things happen for God to display His might and receive glory (v. 1-3)
- II. God's ways may not be traditional, and they leave no doubt who has the power (v. 4-7)
- III. Jesus received the glory when the man testified of what he knew Jesus did for him (v. 8-12)
- 1. What are some things that happened in your life that drew your attention to God?
- 2. Are there any situations in your life that you can't seem to find the reason why it is happening or did happen?
- 3. How has God worked in your life in a way that was not traditional or in a manner that you would not have considered?
- 4. Has God done anything in your life that left no doubt that it was God who accomplished the task?
- 5. What situation recently have you shared with others to give God the glory?
- 6. What situations should you have shared?
- 7. Do you find it difficult to speak of the things God has done for you to others? If so, why?

In this passage, the man born blind experienced a miracle that ultimately pointed people to Jesus. He quickly recognized what happened and gave Jesus glory for it. Remember, he said in verse 11, "the man who is called Jesus...." He had never seen Jesus before, just heard him speak and interacted with him, but that did not detract from him pointing people to Jesus.
