# What About... Deeper Biblical Study, Interpretation, and Application

Simplistic: Observation, Interpretation, Application

Be aware of your own presuppositions and preunderstandings

- these are our underlying <u>assumptions</u> and attitudes
- we carry these into our own interpretation

The most important aspect of the "Interpretive Journey" is discovering what the <u>original author</u> was saying to the <u>original audience</u>.

- the historical-cultural context
- think of reading Scripture like reading <u>over</u> someone's shoulder

Observe, Observe – word repetition, contrasts, comparisons, lists, cause and effect, figures of speech, conjunctions, verbs, pronouns, Q & A, dialogue, means, purpose/result, general to specific and vice versa, conditional clauses, actions/roles of God/people, emotional terms, tone, connections to other paragraphs, shifts and pivots, interchange, chiasm, inclusio

### Step 1: Grasping the Text in Their Town

Q: What did the text mean to the original audience?

- study the historical and literary context
- does the passage relate to those <u>above</u> and <u>below</u>?

## Step 2: Measuring the Width of the River to Cross

Q: What are the <u>differences</u> between the biblical audience and us?

- we are separated by  $\underline{\text{culture}}$ ,  $\underline{\text{language}}$ ,  $\underline{\text{situation}}$ ,  $\underline{\text{time}}$ ,  $\underline{\text{geography}}$ , and often  $\underline{\text{covenant}}$ 
  - note the differences between them and us

#### Step 3: Crossing the Principlizing Bridge

Q: What is the <u>theological</u> principle in this text?

- the universal theological  $\underline{meaning}/\underline{message}$ 

- should be: <u>reflected</u> in the text; <u>timeless</u>; not <u>culturally</u> bound; <u>correspond</u> with Scripture; be <u>relevant</u> to the biblical and the contemporary audience


#### Step 4: Consult the Biblical Map

Q: How does our theological principle fit with the <u>rest</u> of the Bible?

- the "parts-whole" spiral
- what does the NT add or modify the principle?

#### Step 5: Grasping the Text in Own Town

- Q: How should individual Christians today <u>live out</u> the theological principles?
- $\underline{apply}$  the principle to the  $\underline{specific}$  situation of the individual Christians today
  - How should we <u>respond</u> in a "real-life" situation
- there are very few (often 1) principle, but there are <u>numerous</u> applications
