## 2 Timothy – Encouragement to Persevere and Endure

- B. Recalling his calling (v. 8-14)
  - 1. no shame, join in
    - a. because God delivered and called
    - b. not because we are great...
    - c. but because His own <u>plan</u> and kindness
- \*God uses us because, out of His kindness, he allows us into His plan
- \*Us in the plan is only possible through our Rescuer, Jesus, the Messiah
  - 2. Paul was "placed" as...
    - a. a herald or proclaimer
    - b. an apostle
    - c. instructor of Gentiles
- \*from <u>broad</u> to <u>specific</u> (sharer of the Gospel, commissioned by Jesus, exact plan as the teacher to Gentiles)
- \*Zoom In Zoom Out principle
  - 3. Paul expresses value and trust in God
    - a. he was in prison <u>because</u> of what God called him to do
    - b. he is not remorseful (presented as real)
      - i. he was sure in God's ability
      - ii. he trusts God with life deposits
      - iii. no fear for the future
    - c. Paul encourages Timothy
      - i. possess the healthy message...
      - ii. ...in faith and love
      - iii. guard what's been <u>deposited</u> into your life...
- \*it's a play on words Paul trust's God with his life's deposits and wants Timothy to trust what's been deposited in him
  - iv. ...by the  $\underline{\text{indwelling}}\,\text{Holy Spirit}$
- \*The Spirit is what makes all of this life possible
- \*God in us: <u>leading</u>, <u>comforting</u>, interceding, bringing God's Word to memory, among many other things.
  - C. Paul in solitude and refreshed (v. 15-18)
    - 1. Asian Christians abandoned Paul
    - 2. One brought him new <u>life</u> and <u>energy</u>
      - i. no shame or fear of Paul affiliation
      - ii. he went through the trouble...
- \*The "refresher" had a profound impact on Paul
