- · Social pressure Societal norms have and are shifting
- Political pressure Psalm 2
 - The kings of the earth rise up and the rulers band together against the Lord and against his anointed, saying, [3] "Let us break their chains and throw off their shackles." **Psalm 2:2-3**
- Financial pressure Both in the world around us but also personally
- Personal pressure The things we face internally, relationships, family
- Spiritual pressure Very real spiritual battle Ephesians 6.12
- · Peer pressure What are others doing and so what should I be doing

Pressures of:

- Reforming, reshaping, rediscovering Pioneering the new (Isaiah 43.18-19)
- A changing, shifting season
- · Leaving the familiar
- Embracing the unknown

Enemies Strategy

Be alert and of sober mind. <u>Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring</u> <u>lion looking for someone to devour.</u> [9] Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings. **1 Peter 5:8-9**

- Confuse Make something more complex or less easy to understand
- Distract Divert attention, prevent someone from concentrating
- Disorient Lose one's sense of direction
- Deter Discourage from doing something by instilling doubt or fear

Application

1. We need the <u>Humility</u> & <u>Holiness</u> of Moses

• Moses - Wouldn't fight but gave it to the Lord to prove who was right.

Miriam and Aaron oppose Moses

Now Moses was a very humble man, more humble than anyone else on the face of the earth. **Numbers 12:3**

• The Lord himself responded to Miriam and Aarons challenge

Korah, Dathan, Abiram

When Moses heard this, he fell facedown. [5] Then he said to Korah and all his followers: "In the morning the Lord will show who belongs to him and who is holy, and he will have that person come near him. The man he <u>chooses</u> he will cause to come near him. [6] You, Korah, and all your followers are to do this: Take censers [7] and tomorrow put burning coals and incense in them before the Lord. The man the Lord chooses will be the <u>one who is holy</u>. You Levites have gone too far!" **Numbers 16:4-7**

Remedy - Cultivate Humility

"These are the ones I look on with favour: those who are humble and contrite in spirit, and who tremble at my word. **Isaiah 66:2b**

2. We need the Focus & Fortitude of Nehemiah

Nehemiah - Had a grace to not allow the words of Sanballat, Tobias, Gehshem

- Are you rebelling against the King? (Geshem)
 - I answered them by saying, "<u>The God of heaven will give us success.</u> <u>We his servants will start rebuilding</u>, but as for you, you have no share in Jerusalem or any claim or historic right to it." **Nehemiah 2:20**

Chapter 4

- A fox climbing on your wall will break it down, (Tobiah) V3
 - They prayed V4
 - But didn't stop
- Plots of war V7,8 (Sanballat, Tobiag, Arabs)
 - Prayed and posted a guard V9
- Threats and people growing weary
 - They learned to both BUILD while ready for BATTLE V16
- Distraction V1-3 'Come lets meet' Sanballat & Geshem
 - so I sent messengers to them with this reply: "<u>I am carrying on a great</u> project and cannot go down. Why should the work stop while I leave it and go down to you?" **Nehemiah 6:3**
- Intimidation & motives questioned V5-7
 - I sent him this reply: "Nothing like what you are saying is happening; you are just making it up out of your head." [9] They were all trying to frighten us, thinking, "Their hands will get too weak for the work, and it will not be completed." But I prayed, "Now strengthen my hands." Nehemiah 6:8-9

After I looked things over, I stood up and said to the nobles, the officials and the rest of the people, "Don't be afraid of them. Remember the Lord, who is great and awesome, and fight for your families, your sons and your daughters, your wives and your homes." **Nehemiah 4:14**

Remedy - clear prophetic vision

When there is no clear prophetic vision, people quickly wander astray. But when you follow the revelation of the word, heaven's bliss fills your soul. **Proverbs 29:18** TPT

3. We need the <u>Security</u> & <u>Stability</u> of Jesus

 Jesus - was not moved by the praise or criticism of people, rooted in Fathers love

"<u>I do not accept glory from human beings</u>, [44] How can you believe since you accept glory from one another but do not seek the glory that comes from the only God? **John 5:41,44**

The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands. John 3:35

Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, <u>the Son can do nothing</u> <u>by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever</u> <u>the Father does the Son also does</u>. [20] For <u>the Father loves the Son and</u> <u>shows him all he does</u>. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed. **John 5:19-20**

Remedy - Abide in Fathers Love

"As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now <u>remain in my love</u>. **John 15:9**
