See the Father - Revelation, not just distant God but Father "Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me. [26] I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them." **John 17:25-26**

- Father 243 times in the gospels
- Father more than 100 times in John's gospel
- · Jesus came to reconcile a broken, lost world to a loving Heavenly Father

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. [7] If you really know me, you will know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him." **John 14:6-7**

- · Jesus came to reveal Father to us
- He spoke of God as Father

Eternal life Knowing Father

Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent. **John 17:3**

Make our Home - Relational language

Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. John 14:23

See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! ... 1 John 3:1a

Abba, Father

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the <u>children of God</u>. [15] The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the <u>Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship</u>. And <u>by him we cry, "Abba, Father."</u> [16] The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are <u>God's children</u>. **Romans 8:14-16**

- You have rights, privileges, stability, security and it is all rooted in your Fathers love.
- It comes from relationship
- You can call him Abba, Papa, Daddy. Father.
- We are all born with an orphan heart and the only way to remove it is for it to be replaced or displaced with a heart of sonship

ASK - Spirit give me revelation of Father and his love for me

See what the Father is doing

If people <u>can't see what God is doing</u>, <u>they stumble all over themselves</u>; But when they attend to what he reveals, they are most blessed. **Proverbs 29:18** MSG

- If you can't see .. you stumble
- But when you see
- And then you attend you will be blessed

In his defence Jesus said to them, "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working." [19] Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. **John 5:17.19**

- Not only does the Father bring us into the most intimate relationship with himself
- But he call us to bring others into that too

HOW to see what Father is doing

a. Take time to ask

"So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. [10] For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

Luke 11:9-10

.... You do not have because you do not ask God. James 4:2b

b. Be still to listen

My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, **James 1:19**

He says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." **Psalm 46:10**

Do what he shows

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. **James 1.22**

And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" **Luke 2:49** NKJV

But when they attend to what he reveals, they are most blessed. **Proverbs 29:18** MSG
