Apostolic Message -Heaven to Earth August 2021

Introduction

- From heaven to earth by the Spirit
- Planted in the House of the Lord

After this I <u>looked</u>, and there before me was <u>a door standing open</u> in heaven. And <u>the voice</u> I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "<u>Come up here</u>, and I will show you what must take place after this." [2] At once <u>I was in the Spirit</u>, and there before me was a <u>throne in heaven with someone sitting on it</u>. [3] And the one who sat there had the appearance of jasper and ruby. A rainbow that shone like an emerald encircled the throne. [4] Surrounding the throne were twenty-four other thrones, and seated on them were twenty-four elders. They were dressed in white and had crowns of gold on their heads. [5] From the throne came flashes of lightning, rumblings and peals of thunder. In front of the throne, seven lamps were blazing. These are the seven spirits of God. [6] Also in front of the throne there was what looked like a sea of glass, clear as crystal. **Revelation 4:1-6**

Who may ascend the Mountain of the Lord?

The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it; [2] for he founded it on the seas and established it on the waters. [3] Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? [4] The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god. [5] They will receive blessing from the Lord and vindication from God their Saviour. [6] Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek your face, God of Jacob. [7] Lift up your heads, you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in.

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. [2] Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. [3] For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. [4] When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. [5] Put to death, therefore, whatever

belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. **Colossians 3:1-5**

Application -

1. Intimacy with him - Union

So then, just as you <u>received Christ Jesus as Lord</u>, continue to <u>live your lives in him</u>, [7] <u>rooted and built up in him</u>, strengthened in the <u>faith</u> as you were taught, and <u>overflowing with thankfulness</u>. [8] <u>See to it</u> that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ. [9] For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, [10] and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority. **Colossians 2:6-10**

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, <u>set your hearts</u> on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. [2] <u>Set your minds on things above</u>, <u>not on earthly things</u>. [3] For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.
