Main Passage-Matthew 11:20-30

Discussion Questions:

- In what ways might modern people be like Chorazin, Bethsaida, or Capernaum—exposed to Jesus’ works and words yet remaining unrepentant?
- Are there areas in your life where you rely on your own “wisdom and understanding” instead of coming to God like a little child?
- What “heavy burdens” are you (or people around you) currently carrying? How can Jesus’ invitation to find “rest for your souls” apply practically?
- What does it look like today to take Jesus’ yoke upon yourself and learn from Him? How is His yoke “easy” and His burden “light”?
- How does the meekness and lowliness of Jesus (v. 29) challenge common cultural ideas of leadership, power, or success?
- How does this passage deepen your understanding of who Jesus is (both Judge and Savior)?
