Mark 6

- 1. Consider Verses 7-11, what does Jesus tell the Twelve to take with them?
- 2. What do you think this means for us as followers of Christ?
- 3. How do we process the death of John the Baptist? What do we get as faithful servants of Christ?

Mark 7

- 4. Verses 1-23 hone in on the idea of legalism among the Pharisees, what had the Pharisees done that had frustrated Jesus? What does Jesus mean by what comes out of a person is what defiles them?
- 5. What does this mean about the condition of our hearts and how we should protect/guard them?
- 6. What is the difference between legalism and holiness? How do we discern the two?

Mark 8

- 7. In verses 1-13 Jesus feeds another large group, 4,000 to be exact, what example does He set here with compassion toward people?
- 8. Read verses 27-29, we all must answer this question, why is our answer to this question so important?
- 9. Verse 34 marks the call of a believer, to deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Jesus. What does this look like for us on a daily basis?

Mark 9

10. The end of Mark 9 warns against causing others to stumble. What is this warning and what does it reveal about how we should view/fight sin in our lives?

Mark 10

11. In the middle of chapter 10 we see Jesus tell the rich man to "sell everything and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven". What is Jesus getting at here and how should it change our perspective on our identity?
