

What is your greatest need right now?

Read Psalm 63: 1-2

1. David earnestly seeks God. He thirsts for God as in a dry and parched land. How does this imagery help us understand the depth of longing and seeking the Lord?
2. What are some things that compete for our deepest longing? How do we fight against these things taking the main place in our hearts?
3. What causes us to “behold” God’s power & glory, yet still place other things on the throne above him?
4. Although David was running for his life, what does it convey to us about David’s attitude & focus?

Read Psalm 63: 3-8

5. What does Verse 3 mean by “your love is better than life”? What gives David the ability to say this?
6. How do we become “fully satisfied” as David says in verse 5? Practically what does that look like in your day to day life?
7. In verses 6-8 David recounts some instances of God’s faithfulness. Why is it important to look back on God’s faithfulness in our lives?

Read Psalm 63:9-11

8. We see that people are pursuing David in these verses. How does suffering through moments (maybe not exactly the same situation) like these bring us closer to God?
9. Is it difficult for you to trust that God can use your suffering for good?
10. In the message we see a comparison and contrast of duty to God versus delight in God. How do we live in the tension of duty vs. delight? What are some current duties and what are some current delights in your life?
