- 4. Read Titus 2:13.
 - a. When should we be sharing the gospel?
 - b. What should a missional church look like?
 - c. How can our church be more missional? How about your group? Your family? You as an individual?
- 5. Read Titus 2:14.
 - a. Take time to discuss the how and what of our church. What's our mission statement?

 - b. What is the why that should drive the what and the how of what we do as a church and as individual believers?
 - c. How will having the right why change the way our church functions and how we as individual believers live?
 - d. What things in your life to you need to check your "why" on?
 - e. Did you find the words of Simon Sinek interesting? How should his thoughts be that much more apparent if they are applied to the gospel?

 - a. In what different ways should elders be leading the church?
 - b. How should they be leading the church and why must they be sure to faithfully lead without abusing their power?
