

1. Share one of the best worship experiences of your life (corporate, personal, missions, etc)?
2. Read **Psalm 68:1-6** – God moves toward us
 - a. In verse 1 how does the “battle cry” (Numbers 10:35) indicate that David is rejoicing in God’s purposes?
 - b. What is God’s calling us to in verse 5, as well as in James 1:27? How would you explain and describe God’s love for us as it is exemplified in our adoption as His children (Romans 8:14-15; Ephesians 3:19)?
 - c. Who has God brought into your life at just the right time when you needed them? Who in your life right now might need you to be available for them?
3. Read **Psalm 68:7-18** – God moves before us
 - a. How was God’s providence demonstrated through Him leading His people into the promised land? How have you experienced God’s leading in your life?
 - b. Why is verse 18 considered messianic prophecy? How might you explain it in light of Ephesians 4:7-13?
4. Read **Psalm 68:19-27** – God moves among us
 - a. What do Psalm 68:19, Isaiah 46:4, Matthew 11:28 and 1 Peter 5:7 all indicate about God’s desire for the burdens we experience? How should our desire to follow Jesus’ example and Galatians 6:2 point us to walking alongside other believers?
5. Read **Psalm 68:28-35** - God deserves praise from us
 - a. What are some ways that your life, or the life of others around you, exemplifies worship?
 - b. To whom or where might God be calling you to carry out His mission (Matthew 28:18-19)?
