Read Psalm 10:1 - God Hears Our Questions

2. Why do you think God allows his people to honestly ask difficult questions instead of expecting them to hide their doubts?
3. While on the cross, Jesus echoed the words of Psalm 22. How does knowing Jesus experienced this kind of anguish change the way we view our own suffering or unanswered questions?

Read Psalm 10:2-13 - God Sees All Evil

4. What are some situations today where it feels like wickedness is winning? How should we respond without becoming discouraged or cynical?
5. In addition to praying and reading God's word, what are some practical habits that can keep our eyes on God instead of becoming consumed by the brokenness around us?
6. What does living in the light of Christ's victory actually look like during difficult seasons?

Read Psalm 10:14-15 - God Desires Our Trust

7. Why do you think David dramatically shifts his tone from questioning God to trusting Him? Have you experienced that same shift in your own spiritual walk?
8. Why is trusting in God's judgement and justice often more difficult than trying to take matters into our own hands?

Read Psalm 10:16-18 - God Calls For Our Praise

9. Why is worship amidst suffering such a powerful testimony to those around us?

Looking back at Psalm 10, which of these four truths do you need to remember most this week? Pray for strength in those areas.
