Discussion Questions:

What are some characteristics of His body that were discussed? Is anyone else looking forward to the upgrade that is in store for us?
3. Will we be married in heaven? How could that get awkward? How did Jesus answer this question (Matthew 22:29,30)? What was marriage established for (Genesis 2:18)? Will these needs exist in the new heaven? How does marriage show us the ultimate love Jesus has for us, His church?
4. Will our pets be with us in heaven? First, all will there be animals in heaven (Revelation 21:5, Isaiah 11:6-9)? Are we okay with an answer of "perhaps" or "maybe"?
5. Do babies automatically go to heaven when they die? What is the idea of an age of accountability? Does the bible speak to this (Psalm 51:5)? What was Jesus' view of children (Matthew 18:2-5, Matthew 19:14)? What did David say in regards to a child he had lost? What does this seem to imply?
6. What about the person who never hears the gospel? If people who do not hear the gospel are going to hell should we be sharing the gospel? What are the four points we were told to stick to?
