

## **Read 1 Cor. 8:1-3 -Do I genuinely love?**

1. What does Paul mean by “knowledge” here?
2. Why is it important that knowledge and love go in tandem instead of separating the two?  
How does this impact the way we approach one another?
3. Verse 3 says “whoever loves God is known by God”. How is this idea of “love” countercultural from the way we often approach love in our culture?

## **Read 1 Cor. 8:4-6-Am I living in a way that reflects submission to the One True God?**

4. What is the difference in simply acknowledging God versus submitting to him?
5. What are idols or gods in your life? Why must we acknowledge them
6. How do we keep these idols/gods in their rightful place?

## **Read 1 Cor. 8:7-13 Am I quick to defer my liberties?**

7. What is an example of something that could be “permissible” for one person but potentially damaging for another?
8. What is the second most important command? How does this speak to the heart of what Paul is communicating in these verses?
9. What would it look like for the members at Collide to set aside our preferences for the sake of others' spiritual good?
