

v16 And in that day, declares the Lord, you will call me “My husband, and no longer will you call me “My Baal.”


v17 For I will remove the names of the Baals from her mouth, and they shall be remembered by name no more.

God's love is not based on what you do. God's love is based on who He is.

Hebrews 5:2 He can deal gently with the ignorant and wayward.

“Consider what all this means. When we sin, we are encouraged to bring our mess to Jesus because he will know just how to receive us. He doesn’t handle us roughly. He doesn’t scowl and scold. He doesn’t lash out, the way many of our parent did. And all this restraint on his part is not because he has a diluted view of our sinfulness. He knows our sinfulness far more deeply than we do. His restraint simply flows from his tender heart for his people.” Dane Ortlund
