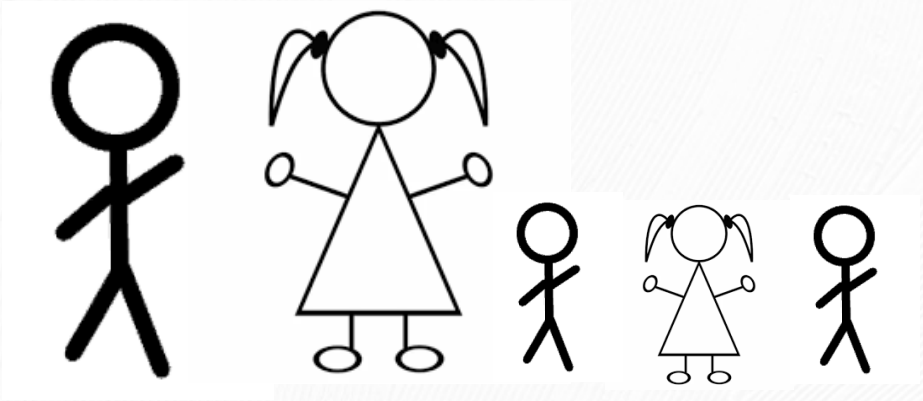
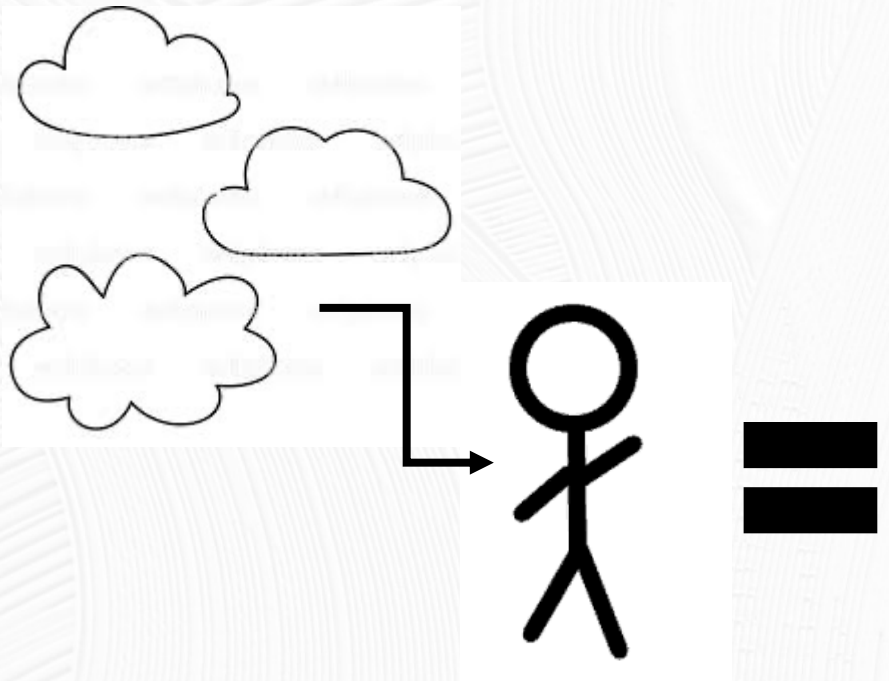

Near Fulfillment - Dynasty of Jahu ended

Far Fulfillment – Israel will be defeated by Assyria, and they will be scattered and no longer a strong force
