Three Reasons People Don't Believe

The Illusion of Scientism (John 20:24-29)

- 1. Distinction between science and scientism
 - Definition of science- The systematic study and theoretical explanation of the <u>material</u> world through established procedures for the purpose of understanding, application, and control.
 - b. Definition of scientism- The philosophical belief that the hard sciences—like chemistry, biology, physics, and astronomy— provide the only genuine knowledge of reality.
- 2. The promises of scientism
 - a. Meaning without God: You can find your own <u>purpose</u> for existence. You can create your own <u>identity</u>, truth, and reason for living.
 - b. Immortality without heaven: <u>technology</u> is trying to overcome philosophy, which is contemplation about life in the face of death.
 - c. Progress without <u>limit</u>: This is an evolutionary view of the world that says things can only get <u>better</u>, and science is the way that happens.
- 3. The failure of scientism
 - a. The limits of science
 - i. Science can only address the material world.
 - ii. All scientific data must be interpreted.
 - iii. Science must regularly revise and rescind its pronouncements.
 - iv. Science is not a neutral endeavor, but always done by <u>finite</u>, flawed, and biased people.
 - v. Science must be <u>funded</u> and so is influenced by money.
 - vi. Scientists disagree all the time about all kinds of things
 - vii. The <u>catastrophic failure</u> of engineered products previously approved by scientists
 - b. The failed promises of progress: <u>100 million</u> dead in "the modern century," all in the name of progress by the most advanced nations

The Indulgence of Sex (2 Peter 2:17-22)

- 1. Rebellion against God's limits
 - a. The heart of the moral revolution in the 1960's and today is a <u>refusal</u> to let God limit sexual expression.

- b. Sometimes the person raising <u>intellectual</u> objections to Christianity is really just covering for his objection to God's limits of sex.
- 2. Rejection of God's image as male and female
 - a. Denial of a fixed human nature.
 - b. Denial of difference between the sexes
 - c. Sexual orientation is identity. Biology no longer matters.
 - d. Any limits on sexual expression is <u>oppression</u> designed to render the individual inauthentic.
- 3. Abolition of the family
 - a. The sexual revolution ultimately has one great goal: the abolition of the family.
 - b. The means by which this demolition can happen is <u>technology</u>.
 - c. The separation of sex from <u>procreation</u> was followed by the separation of procreation from the <u>family</u>, and now concluded with the separation of reproduction from <u>sex</u>.

The Idolatry of the Self (Jer. 6:16-19)

- 1. The intolerance of authority and accountability: In the postmodern world, all authorities have been <u>deconstructed</u> and shown to be flawed. Therefore, everyone must be an authority <u>unto</u> themselves.
- 2. The interiority of experience.
- 3. The acceptance of anything but God (Matt. 27:15-23)

The Solution of the Gospel

- 1. Access to ultimate truth that scientism seeks.
- 2. Freedom from the tyranny of desire that sexual immorality brings.
- 3. Escape from the enslavement to self that individualism produces.
