Matthew 2:1—3 (TPT) 1 Jesus was born in Bethlehem near Jerusalem during the reign of King Herod. After Jesus' birth a group of spiritual priests from the East came to Jerusalem 2 and inquired of the people, "Where is the child who is born king of the Jewish people? We observed his star rising in the sky and we've come to bow before him in worship."

3 King Herod was shaken to the core when he heard this, and not only he, but all of Jerusalem was disturbed when they heard this news.

**Daniel 1:19-20** (NIV) **19** The king talked with them, and he found none equal to Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah; so they entered the king's service. **20** In every matter of wisdom and understanding about which the king questioned them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and enchanters in his whole kingdom.

**Daniel 5:11** (NIV) **11** There is a man[Daniel] in your kingdom who has the spirit of the holy gods in him. In the time of your father he was found to have insight and intelligence and wisdom like that of the gods. Your father, King Nebuchadnezzar, appointed him chief of the magicians, enchanters, astrologers and diviners.

And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.
