### The Righteous Will Live By Faith

Habakkuk 2:4 (NIV '84) "See, he is puffed up; his desires are not upright but the righteous will live by his faith

## I. The First Question And Answer - Habakkuk 1:2-11

Habakkuk 1:2-3 (NIV '84) How long, O LORD, must I call for help, but you do not listen?
Or cry out to you, "Violence!" but you do not save?
Why do you make me look at injustice?
Why do you tolerate wrongdoing?
Destruction and violence are before me; there is strife, and conflict abounds.

# Habakkuk uses the terms '*how long*' and '*why*', but what he is really asking is 'p*lease <u>stop</u>*' the violence

Habakkuk 1:5-6 (NIV '84) Look at the nations and watch and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe, even if you were told. I am raising up the Babylonians...

God says He will stop violence in Israel by allowing the Babylonians to <u>conquer</u> Israel

**Zephaniah 1:2** (NIV) "I will sweep away everything from the face of the earth," declares the Lord.

### II. The Second Question And Answer - Habakkuk 1:12-2:20

Habakkuk 1:13, 17 (NIV '84) ...Why then do you tolerate the treacherous? Why are you silent while the wicked swallow up those more righteous than themselves?

Is he to keep on emptying his net, destroying nations without mercy?

# Habakkuk is saying this solution does not do away with violence but rather <u>increases</u> violence

Habakkuk 2:3-4 (NIV '84) For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false.
Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay.
"See, he is puffed up; his desires are not upright—but the righteous will live by his faith

God is promising to <u>end</u> violence by the coming of one who will establish a kingdom without violence

God is telling the prophet and all people that they must wait and believe until the revelation arrives

#### III. The Prayer/Psalm

 Habakkuk 3:16 (NIV '84) I heard and my heart pounded, my lips quivered at the sound; decay crept into my bones, and my legs trembled.
 Yet I will wait patiently for the day of calamity to come on the nation invading us.

🚹 Habakkuk says he will wait and believe

God is calling us to wait and believe, too. God is calling all of us to live by <u>faith</u>.
