## **I. Good Judgement** − A Decision

**Luke 18:25** (NIV) <sup>25</sup> Indeed, it is **easier for a camel** to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is **rich to enter the kingdom of God.**"

**Proverbs 8:1-3, 10-11, 30-31** (NIV) <sup>1</sup> Does not wisdom call out? Does not understanding raise her voice? <sup>2</sup> At the highest point along the way, where the paths meet, she takes her stand; <sup>3</sup> beside the gate leading into the city, at the entrance, she cries aloud:

- ¹º Choose my instruction instead of silver, knowledge rather than choice gold, ¹¹ for wisdom is more precious than rubies, and nothing you desire can compare with her.
