I. Beginning With the End in Mind

Matthew 24:10—14 (NIV) ¹⁰ At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, ¹¹ and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. ¹² Because of the increase of wickedness/lawlessness, the love of most will grow cold, ¹³ but he who stands firm to the end will be saved. ¹⁴ And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

Jesus' casualty warnings and instruction:

- 1) Some self-select out
- 2) Some are <u>casualties</u> of deception
- 3) Some lose their love
- 4) Solution is for all to stand firm

Why we don't need to be afraid:

Galatians 3:1—3 (NIV) ¹You foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? Before your very eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed as crucified. ² I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by **believing what you heard**? ³ Are you so foolish? After **beginning by means of the Spirit**, are you now trying to finish by means of the flesh?

You began by **believing** the message <u>Faith</u>

You **recognized** God's Word in your spirit Holy Spirit

We are saved by faith and a supernatural work of God. The only way we can stand in the last days is to have faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and rely on the supernatural help of God's Holy Spirit.

John 10:27 (NIV) 27 My sheep listen to my voice, I know them and they follow me.

III. Standing is About Character

Ezekiel 22:30 (NIV) ³⁰ "I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and **stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land** so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one."

A Biblical Example: Esther

Esther 4:14—16 (NIV) ¹⁴ For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place, but you and your father's family will perish. And who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?" ¹⁵ Then Esther sent this reply to Mordecai: ¹⁶ "Go, gather together all the Jews who are in Susa, and fast for me. Do not eat or drink for three days, night or day. I and my attendants will fast as you do. When this is done, I will go to the king, even though it is against the law. And if I perish, I perish."

Isaiah 66:8 (NIV) ⁸ Who has ever heard of such things? Who has ever seen things like this? Can a country be born in a day or a nation be brought forth in a moment? Yet no sooner is Zion in labor than she gives birth to her children."
