2 Timothy 2:20-21 (NIV '84) In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.

The Large (or Great) House Illustration

- Part of a discussion about what Timothy needs to be a good pastor / to do good ministry
- Timothy needs to have both competency and character
- The Large House Illustration focuses on character
- It applies to us all

I. The Contrast

2 Timothy 2:20 (NIV '84) In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble.

2 Timothy 2:20 (Message) In a well-furnished kitchen there are not only crystal goblets and silver platters, but waste cans and compost buckets— some containers used to serve fine meals, others to take out the garbage.

All of us have these things, this contrast, inside of us

- The Four Personality Types
- "Sometimes I'm Samson" by Larry Bryant

Sometimes I'm Samson with the strength to conquer anything. Sometimes I'm David when my heart is right and I feel just like a king. Sometimes I'm Thomas when disbelief takes hold.

This contrast is in us all

2 Timothy 2:21 (NIV '84) If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.
This <i>can</i> be done. This <i>should</i> be done.
This is elimination, not addition
2 Kings 23:6 (NIV) [Josiah] took the Asherah pole from the temple of the Lord to the Kidron Valley outside Jerusalem and burned it there
The ignoble is not always <u>obvious</u>
Colossians 3:5-8 (NIV) 5 Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. 6 Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. 7 You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. 8 But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips.
●The ignoble is not always <u>sinful</u>
1 Corinthians 6:12 (NIV '84) "Everything is permissible for me" - but not everything is beneficial. "Everything is permissible for me" - but I will not be mastered by anything. (Compare to 1 Corinthians 10:23)
