Matthew 6:11 (NIV) 11 Give us today our daily bread.

# C. Prayer develops fullness and joy

John 16:24 (NIV) 24 Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.

# D. Prayer is the cure for anxiety, worry, and trouble

Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV) 6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

#### E. Skepticism and unbelief dissolve before answered prayer

I Kings 18:39 (NIV) 39 When all the people saw this, they fell prostrate and cried, "The Lord—he is God! The Lord—he is God!"

### F. Prayer delivers the power of the Holy Spirit for ministry

Luke 11:13 (NIV) 13 If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!

#### G. Prayer opens the door of salvation

Romans 10:13 (NIV) 13 for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

# III. The Answer to Prayer is Receiving

Mark 11:24 (NIV) 24 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

Matthew 7:9-10 (NIV) 9 Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? 10 Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake?

# IV. How to Pray in God's Will and Authority

Psalms 37:4 (NIV) 4 Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.

Matthew 18:18-20 (NIV) 18 "Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. 19 Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. 20 For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."
