I. _____. *Karpou*, "something naturally produced". Also translated as *harvest, crops, and even descendants*.

Matthew 3:8 (NIV) **8** Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.

Matthew 7:16-17 (NIV) **16** By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? **17** Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.

Ephesians 5:9 (NIV) **9** (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth)




Philippians 1:11 (NIV) **11** filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.
