Grasshopper/Grasshoppers - 9 times in the Bible Locust/Locusts - 36 times in the Bible

They play their biggest role in the book of Joel.

I. Joel's Structure

Part 1 - A Present Punishment For Violence - Joel 1

Joel 1:6-7 (NIV) A nation has invaded my land, a mighty army without number; it has the teeth of a lion, the fangs of a lioness. It has laid waste my vines and ruined my fig trees. It has stripped off their bark and thrown it away, leaving their branches white.

Part 2 - A Future Punishment for Violence - Joel 2

Joel 2:2-3 (NIV) ...Like dawn spreading across the mountains a large and mighty army comes, such as never was in ancient times nor ever will be in ages to come. Before them fire devours, behind them a flame blazes. Before them the land is like the garden of Eden, behind them, a desert waste — nothing escapes them.

Part 3 - An Ultimate Punishment for Violence - Joel 3

Joel 3:2 (NIV) I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will put them on trial for what they did to my inheritance, my people Israel...

Joel 3:18 (NIV) In that day the mountains will drip new wine, and the hills will flow with milk; all the ravines of Judah will run with water. A fountain will flow out of the Lord's house and will water the valley of acacias.

II. The (Not So) Secret In The Structure

Joel 2:28-32 (NIV) And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days. I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and billows of smoke. The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord. And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved; for on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there will be deliverance, as the Lord has said, even among the survivors whom the Lord calls.

Acts 2:14-21 (NIV) Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd: "Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. These people are not drunk, as you suppose. It's only nine in the morning! No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke. The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the

Romans 10:12-13 (NIV) For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

great and glorious day of the Lord. And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'

 The (not-so) secret in the structure is that the Kingdom exists now and we can participate in the Kingdom now.

"If everyone here were like Ned Flanders, there'd be no need for heaven. We'd already be there." - Homer Simpson

"The Gospel is less about how to get into the Kingdom of Heaven after you die, and more about how to live in the Kingdom of Heaven before you die." - Dallas Willard

This involves at least two things:

A) Repenting Of What Is Anti-Kingdom or Un-Kingdom

Joel 2:13 (NIV) Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity.

- Anti-Kingdom violence
- Un-Kingdom anxiety, fear, worry

B) Sharing What Is Kingdom

Joel 2:28 (NIV) ...I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

III. Dual Citizenship

Philippians 3:20 (NIV) But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ
