23 "When Moses was forty years old, he decided to visit his own people, the Israelites. 24 He saw one of them being mistreated by an Egyptian, so he went to his defense and avenged him by killing the Egyptian.

Exodus 3:1–2 (NIV) 1 Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. 2 There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up.

Deuteronomy 34:9—10 (NIV) **9** Now Joshua son of Nun was filled with the spirit of wisdom because Moses had laid his hands on him. Numbers 12:5—9 (NIV) **5** Then the Lord came down in a pillar of cloud; he stood at the entrance to the tent and summoned Aaron and Miriam. When the two of them stepped forward, **6** he said, "Listen to my words: "When there is a prophet among you,

I, the Lord, reveal myself to them in visions,

I speak to them in dreams.
