**25** He said to them, "How foolish you are, and how slow to believe all that the prophets have spoken! **26 Did not the Messiah have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?"** **27** And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

**Luke 24:1—8** (NIV) *The Resurrection story...* **1** On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. **2** They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, **3** but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. **4** While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. **5** In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? **6** He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: **7** 'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'" **8** Then they remembered his words.
