- 2. What substitutes do we accept?

John 10:9–11 (NIV) <sup>9</sup> I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. <sup>10</sup> The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

<sup>11</sup> "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep."

- God's Way: A) Gives us <u>life</u> and freedom
  - B) Jesus laid down <u>His life</u> to rescue us

# Satan's Way: A) Deception and lies

- B) <u>Destroys</u> your life
- A. Religious Legalism = <u>Pharisees and Foolish Galatians</u>

**Galatians 3:1** (NIV) <sup>1</sup> You **foolish Galatians**! Who has bewitched you? Before your very eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed as crucified.

Matthew 23:23-24 (NIV) <sup>23</sup> "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices—mint, dill and cumin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law—justice, mercy and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former. <sup>24</sup> You blind guides! You strain out a gnat but swallow a camel.

- B. False gods = <u>Have no other gods before me</u>
  - Idolatry
  - False Religions
  - Witchcraft, divination, and the occult
  - Wealth and health
  - Addictions and substances
- C. Humanism = We don't need God. Together we can solve this.

**Colossians 2:8** (NIV) <sup>8</sup> See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ.

- Atheism: "There is no God"
- Scientism: "Science has disproved God"
- Pluralism: "All paths are equally valid"
- Humanism: "We don't need God"
- **Relativism**: "True for you but not for me"
- Hedonism: "Whatever makes you happy"

The difficulty for us: None of these life approaches will allow for one to believe in God. Currently, many who approach life from these perspectives are *intolerant of those who believe in God*.

**Psalm 19:1-4** (NIV) <sup>1</sup> The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. <sup>2</sup> Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. <sup>3</sup> They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them. <sup>4</sup> Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens God has pitched a tent for the sun.

How can I be free - Fear Free? Put your trust completely in God
