I. Finding Your Place

Proverbs 27:8 (NKJV) ⁸ Like a bird that wanders from its nest is a man who wanders from his place.

 Your place is not a geographical one but one within the body and family of God

 What kind of member are you?

2 Timothy 1:8–9 (NKJV) ⁸ Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God, ⁹ who has **saved us** and **called us** with a holy calling, not according to our works, but **according to His own purpose** and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began

 You are saved and called for His purpose

A) It Takes Faith to Find Your Place

Matthew 17:20 (NIV) ²⁰ He replied, "Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

B) Humility is Essential to Finding Your Place

Romans 12:3 (NIV) ³ For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you.

C) Personal Responsibility: What Has God Given You?

Matthew 25:14–15 (NIV) ¹⁴ "Again, it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted his wealth to them. ¹⁵ To one he gave five bags of gold, to another two bags, and to another one bag, each according to his ability. Then he went on his journey.

Ephesians 1:22–23 (NIV) ²² And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, ²³ which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.

Romans 12:4–5 (NIV) ⁴ For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

Amos 3:3 (NIV) Do two walk **together** unless they have **agreed** to do so?
