III. How to Devour God's Word Healthily...

A. Know the Genre

Matthew 4:4 (NIV) Jesus defends himself against Stan's lie... **4** Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.' [Deut. 8:3]" (Jesus uses a historical text to rebuff the tempter.)

B. Practice Good Grammar

John 10:7-8 (NIV) Jesus the Good Shepherd... 7 Therefore Jesus said again, "Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. 8 All who have come before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them. (Jesus is not literally a door. You are not sheep. This is a metaphor for teaching.)

C. Word Studies and Themes (Scripture with Scripture)

Genesis 2:23-24 (NIV) Creation of Man and Woman... 23 The man said, "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called 'woman,' for she was taken out of man."24 That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh.
