I. Good Days and Bad - *We all have them.*

John 12:12-13 (TLB) ¹² The next day, the news that Jesus was on the way to Jerusalem swept through the city, and a huge crowd of Passover visitors ¹³ took palm branches and went down the road to meet him, shouting, "The Savior! God bless the King of Israel! Hail to God's Ambassador!"

 Don't let your days change who you are

II. A Bigger Picture

John 12:14-15 (TLB) ¹⁴ Jesus rode along on a young donkey, fulfilling the prophecy that said: ¹⁵ "Don't be afraid of your King, people of Israel, for he will come to you meekly, sitting on a donkey's colt!"

Zechariah 9:9-10 (NIV) Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey. ¹⁰... He will proclaim peace to the nations. His rule will extend... to the ends of the earth.

 God's big picture is clearly established in scripture

III. Sometimes We are Slow to See the Big Picture

John 12:16 (TLB) ¹⁶ (His disciples didn't realize at the time that this was a fulfillment of prophecy; but after Jesus returned to his glory in heaven, then they noticed how many prophecies of Scripture had come true before their eyes.)
